Have you met Dick Hilton?

Dick Hilton, a retired United Healthcare agent, had a table at the Volunteer Forum Wellness Fair cohosted by Saco Parks and Recreation and Age Friendly Saco on November 4th. He offers those interested free help sorting out health plans supplemental to Medicare and drug insurance options. He met with four individuals and one couple, who made adjustments to health or drug plans saving a total of \$7670. These adjustments were made prior to the end of the enrollment period, but Dick stresses there are insurance adjustments that can be made at any time of the year. He also assists people signing up for Maine Care or similar options. He will be available by appointment at the Community Center in the Age Friendly Saco office, Mondays between 9 and 1. It's That Time of Year Again

If you or your household made less than \$54,000 in 2017, there is free tax preparation assistance available from York County Community Action Corp. The tax preparation will take place at the Biddeford Office on York Street on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Call the tax line at 324-5762, x2718 to make an appointment.

York County Community Action Corporation (YCCAC) has been awarded a two-year \$50,000 grant by the Maine Cancer Foundation. YCCAC's transportation program will use the grant to operate "Connecting to Cancer Care," in strong partnership with the medical providers treating persons diagnosed with cancer, in 2018 and 2019. The program is available to residents of York County who have a cancer diagnosis, need transportation to treatment or related appointments, and do not have other means of transportation. Handy Neighbor Program

Age Friendly Saco's Assessment revealed that the #1 request seniors had is for handyman services. Age Friendly Saco (AFS) is developing a "Handy Neighbor" program to help seniors with simple maintenance needs that they cannot do themselves. Clients must be 60 or older, priority given to those least able to pay. Examples of some tasks they will do: changing storm windows and screens, changing light bulbs, installing handrails and putting away summer furniture. Volunteers would not do seasonal tasks such as snow shoveling or raking leaves, nor would they do tasks which would normally require a licensed contractor. This is a developing program. Eventually AFS will vet contractors who are willing to do small jobs at reasonable rates for seniors.
