Rides To Medical Appointments

If you are 60+ years old or have a disability, you may be eligible for our free transportation service to medical appointments. We welcome Saco residents who live in their own home/rent or reside in an independent living facility to register and schedule rides by calling (207)-200-7668. Rides are provided by caring people who give their time to help others. Volunteers are screened, trained and required to keep confidentiality. All rides depend on volunteer availability, therefore, we request at least a 7 day notice when scheduling a ride. The door-todoor service includes destinations from Kennebunk to Falmouth. While there is no charge for our services, donations are welcome. We look forward to hearing from vou!

WHY DO I WANT ONE? WHY WOULD I NEED ONE?




Whether you live alone or not, have you ever given thought to.....

What would happen if I had an emergency and couldn't open the door to allow rapid entry by the emergency technicians/the fire department? Yes, I am healthy today.....tomorrow I may fall or experience another kind of health emergency..... Maybe I won't be able to crawl to the door to allow them in my home.

The Fire Department would have to look for another home entry before forcibly entering and possibly causing damage to your front door. This takes time. What if time is of the essence? **Enter the Knox Box...**

This relatively small fixture is attached to your front door and looks quite innocuous. Inside is the key to your house which can only be accessed by the Saco Fire Department. Once installed, your address is listed on a site map at the department along with any emergency

contacts.

Through the support of a grant by the Huntington

SAFETY TIPS FOR SENIORS

Consider:

grab bars
waterproof seat or chair in shower/tub
rubber backed bathmat
lever type door handles
plug-in light sensors
orange tape to floor hazards
have working flash lights on hand
scatter rugs can slip underfoot-remove them or stick them in place
give a spare house key to a trusted neighbor
install a Knox Box
update smoke detectors, replace batteries if needed
know where your shut off water valve is located
post emergency numbers in conspicuous locations
add emergency contacts to your cell phone

IMPORTANT PROPERTY TAX SAVINGS INFORMATION

If you received the **SACO SENIOR TAX ASSISTANCE** program for 2022, this is a reminder that you must reapply yearly. To reapply or to apply for the first time, you must have filed a ME 1040 form for 2022 to be eligible. The application deadline is July 1, 2023. Forms are available at City Hall and our office. Please contact our office for the specific program requirements, information or application assistance.

The ME PROPERTY TAX STABILIZATION PROGRAM (also known as the Real Estate tax freeze) is in danger of being replaced or eliminated. State Representatives are concerned because the program has no income guidelines at present. This popular program which has a filing deadline of December 1st. is being discussed and re-worked by the State Taxation Committee. Watch the news for updated information.
