Age Friendly Saco's Handy Neighbor Program services are free.



How Much Does it Cost?

The Age Friendly Saco's Handy Neighbor Program services by our Volunteers are performed at no charge.

All costs for materials used in the service, installation or repair work is the responsibility of the Resident.

Age Friendly Saco can provide the following items at low cost or reduced cost:

- Grab Bars
- CO2 Detectors
- Smoke Detectors

Examples of Services Provided

A sample of the services our volunteers provide are:

- Install grab bars and handrails
- Install smoke and/or CO2 detectors
- Change lightbulbs
- Install/remove air conditioning units
- Hang screens
- Weather-stripping
- Move furniture
- Minor home repairs
- Assemble packaged items

The services are intended to be a simple one-time service that does not require a license to perform.

Services We Cannot Provide

- Any repair or service which requires a license to perform
- Any service requiring the need to climb an extension ladder
- Remove mold/clean water damage
- Replace light fixtures
- Install fencing
- Plow snow/Snowblow or Shoveling
